Morehead candidate

Travis Day is selected by committee

Travis Shelton Day, son of Richard Earl and Ellen Bercegeay Day, Morehead City, has been nominated for a Morehead Scholarship to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

He was chosen from among five candidates from West Carteret and East Carteret high schools.

Mr. Day's nomination advances him to the district competition, scheduled next week, in which 20 candidates from 11 counties will compete to advance to the final round of interviews next spring in Chapel Hill.

About 60 Morehead Scholarships are awarded each year by the Morehead Foundation to high school students who demonstrate exceptional leadership, academic standing, character and physical vigor.

The foundation was established by John Motley Morehead, a 1891 graduate of UNC-Chapel Hill.

The four-year Morehead Scholarship is worth about \$8,000 per year to an in-state student, including a summer stipend.

Mr. Day is a senior at West Carteret High School, where he is a member of the National Honor Society and president of his class.

He is participating in the N.C. Scholars Program. He received academic achievement awards and was recognized as a scholar athlete his sophomore and junior years.

He played on the Patriot soccer team his junior and senior years and on the wrestling team his sophomore, junior and senior years. In wrestling, Mr. Day was conference champion and regional runner-up his sophomore and junior years. As a sophomore he was a state runner-up, was named to the all-state wrestling team, and received a most outstanding wrestling award.

Mr. Day was nominated to the N.C. School of Science and Mathematics, Durham. In the annual math contest at East Carolina University, Greenville, he placed third in the geometry competition as a sophomore and was on the second-place comprehensive math team as a junior.

He has served on the student council since his sophomore year, when he was student body treasurer. Since then, he has been class president.

He was a member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) his junior year and Students Against Drunk Driving (SADD) and the chess club his sophomore year. This year, he is a member of the Spanish, art and surfing clubs.

As a junior, he attended Boy's State and Governor's School. As a sophomore, he attended the Eastern Student Athlete Summer Institute Alcohol and Drug Defense Program.

Other local candidates were as follows:

William Lyle Marquardt, son of Dennis M. and Leslie R. Marquardt, Spooner's Creek, and a senior at West Carteret High School.

Alfred Braswell Cooper III, son of Pamela W. and Alfred B. Cooper Jr., Atlantic Beach, and a senior at West Carteret High School.

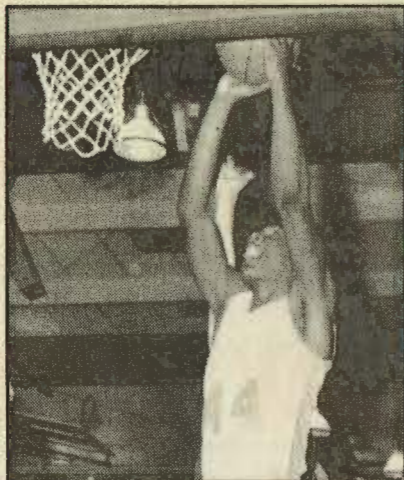
